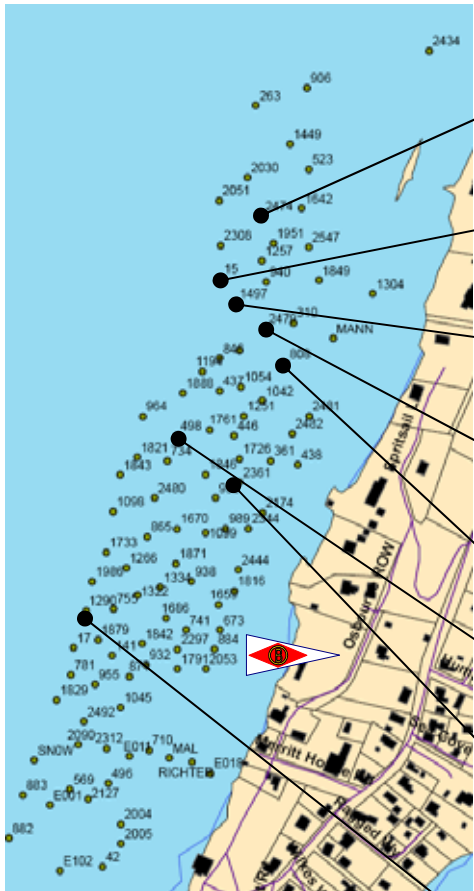

Water is available at the float, however due to well limits, please conserve water. **Trash disposal** is in the dumpster located to the right of the front porch. **Heads** are available for use in the Club House. Please tie up dinghies on the inside of the south float. Gas and Diesel may be obtained at Cook's Lobsterhouse dock. Local restaurants are Salt Cod Café (located in the red building just before the Cribstone Bridge) and Cook's Lobsterhouse Restaurant (go across Cribstone Bridge, up the hill a bit and take a right onto Garrison Cove Road to the end).
